March 9–10, 2007

The **2-day Workshop titled: New Media For Teaching And Learning In Professional Education And Practice** will be primarily conducted by **Prof. Denise Burnette** and **Assistant Dean Ann McCann Oakley** from the Columbia University School of Social Work (CUSSW). Prof. Burnette is currently at TISS as a Fulbright Scholar and her colleague Assistant Dean McCann Oakley will be visiting India for a brief duration in early March of this year. Professors Burnette and McCann Oakley have been involved in the CUSSW's initiatives in developing innovative and responsive Instructional Technology to enhance teaching and learning through the use of technology.

In this context, the Centre for Lifelong Learning is organising the above Workshop in order to provide a platform for Professors Burnette and McCann Oakley to share their experiences in the same and facilitate the exploration of taking on such initiatives in both academics and practice in India. The main aim is to enhance the competency of trainers and educators in the diverse Helping Professions that cut across the education, health, human resource development and social development sectors in effectively and innovatively utilising educational technology to enrich the teaching–learning process.

1. Understand basic concepts and principles of new media technology.
2. Describe the application of several innovative uses of new media to enhance professional education.
3. Describe the application of several innovative uses of new media to enhance professional practice.
4. Identify and access resources for using new media for education and practice.

2. Developments and demonstration of local and distance education
3. Developments and demonstration of practice innovations using new media
4. Ethical and practical issues in use of new media
