### **Advertisement for Posts of Research Assistants**

The University of Chicago Centre in Delhi and Tata Institute of Social Sciences (Mumbai) seek Research Assistants for their ongoing academic collaborative research project '**Slum Clearance, Urban Restructuring and (Re)Emergent Communities in Mumbai**'. The project focuses on dimensions of urban redevelopment and aims to explore the impact of resettlement on individuals, families, and communities; and of urban restructuring policies and local community life on current circumstances and well-being of the urban poor. The project is inter-disciplinary in nature.

Interested applicants from diverse fields of study, i.e. Public Policy, Social Work, Development Studies, Urban and Habitat Studies and allied social science fields; those with M.Phil. and/or PhD. with research interests and academic contributions in the themes of urban poverty, urban renewal and urban settlements, are encouraged to apply.
