**Key Decisions taken after meeting the Students Delegation with Team of Administration on 22 February 2018 at 7:45pm at the Office of the Director to consider the Charter of Demands made by the TISS Students' Union dated 20th February.**

The meeting was scheduled at 4:30pm However, the students delegation turned up at 7:45pm.

**Demand No.1 & 2: Payment of fees by students who are eligible for GoI PMS**

In partial modification of the notification dated 25th May, 2017, regarding payment of fees by SC/ST students eligible for GoI PMS, following decisions were made in the meeting.

1. For the 2016-18 batch: All the SC/ST GoI-PMS scholarship holders registered for the Masters' programme in 2016-18 will be permitted to continue with their studies and appear for exams in March- April, 2018. For this batch, the hostel charges are waived off. The dining hall charges will be payable by them but are being deferred until the time that the students have the means to do so (i.e. as and when they receive the scholarship amount from the government into their accounts or when they get employed).
2. For 2017-2019 and 2018-2020 batches: The course fee including tuition fee will continue to be waived off for the SC/ST students eligible for GoI PMS. Only the Hostel and Dining Hall charges, on actuals, shall be payable. The Institute is making several efforts to augment resources for the students to meet the above components.


**Demand No. 3: Hostel and Dining Hall fees for students of BA/MA Integrated programme of the Off Campuses**

The point was not taken for discussion.

**Demand No. 4: Symbolic Representation of office of Dean SPO from SC/ST OBC Category**

Dr. S. Darokar has already been appointed as Associate Dean, in the Standing Committee Meeting, w.e.f. September 7, 2015.
