About Tata Institute of Social Sciences

The Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) was established in 1936 as the Sir Dorabji Tata Graduate School of Social Work in Mumbai to create human service professionals to address the issues of unemployment and poverty in the context of the Great Depression of the 1930s. In 1944, it was renamed as the Tata Institute of Social Sciences, and in 1964 the Government of India (GoI) declared TISS as Deemed to be a University under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956. The vision of Tata Institute of Social Sciences has been to be an institution of excellence in higher education that continually responds to changing social realities through the development and application of knowledge, towards creating a people- centred, ecologically sustainable and just society that promotes and protects dignity, equality, social justice and human rights for all. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) rated TISS with a score of 3.89 out of 4.00, the second highest score among universities accredited thus far. As per the Gazette notification (dated February 12,2018) TISS is recognized as category 1 university. TISS NIRF Rank is 57 (overall)/ 34 (All University). In December 2011, Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) set up the School of Vocational Education (SVE) to provide immediate and definite interventions to improve the skill levels of millions of youth, through appropriate vocational training programmes.

About School of Vocational Education (SVE)

The approach adopted by TISS-SVE is called the '**Internship Embedded Skill Training Programme**'. The Vocational Educational Programme is being implemented for the first time in India with a focus on job-specific skills rather than providing only a broad knowledge based education. The aim of this '**Earn While You Learn Model**' is to enable the students to learn the skill by engaging in internship at real shop floor of the industry/company along with theory training in the classroom. Through this

model, the student may also earn a modest stipend during internship of the course. Although, stipend is not mandatory for the Skill Knowledge Providers, TISS-SVE strongly encourages Skill Knowledge Providers (SKPs) to adopt this practice.

- Interns will receive a certificate or/and letter of experience only after the successful and satisfactory completion of the internship period.
- Depending on the performance evaluation at the end of the internship and submission of internship report, stipend will be payable at INR 10,000/- per month for a maximum period of two months.
- Internship is not a guarantee of employment with the SVE and/or TISS.
- Students will be shortlisted on the basis of screening of their resumes followed by a selection process. Only selected interns will be contacted for providing information on the areas of study, period of internship, location etc.
