ALL ELIGIBLE JUNIOR/SENIOR STUDENTS

(Inte. BA-MA/M.A./Inte. M.Phil-Ph.D./Dir. Ph.D. PROGRAMMES)
(Mumbai, Tuljapur and BALM Campus)

[GOI-POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME]

This is to bring to the notice of all students (SC/ST) who have claimed fees exemption that they are mandatorily required to submit the Government of India Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme Application Forms (on-line/off-line) at the earliest along with all necessary documents. The list of documents required to be submitted are displayed on the Notice Board of SC/ST & EO Cells. Kindly note that the application forms of GOI-PMS (on-line/off-line) are to be submitted **every year** (Fresh application in the first year (Juniors), Renewal application in the second year (seniors), and Renewal application in the third year (for BA and Ph.D. third year).

It is the individual, eligible student's responsibility to fill and submit the on-line/off-line application form of GOI-PMS for the Academic Year 2018-19 within the specific time frame announced by the concerned authority of the respective State Government. Students failing to fill the application forms for any reason by the prescribed due date will be considered as not being interested to be considered for GOI-PMS and the entire exempted fees [including Dining Hall/Hostel Charges and advances (if any) in case of seniors] will be recovered in full by the Institute. The release of the grade card / degrees shall be subject to payment of all fees in such cases.

(A) STUDENTS FROM OTHER STATES [SC/ST/OBC(NC)]

The State Governments will announce the details of the scheme and invite applications during the period from June to Decembert, 2018. The eligible SC/ST/OBC(NC) students should fill and submit the on-line/off-line application form within the date specified by the respective State Governments. It is the responsibility of the individual eligible student to complete and submit the application forms.

Wherever the State Government/Authority Concerned have indicated that the GOI-PMS application form (on-line/hard copy) will be accessed/issued after 31 August, 2018, the students are required to submit an application indicating the tentative date of submission of GOI-PMS application form to the SC/ST Cell respective campus. Also submit the hard copy of scholarship application (if online) alongwith photo copies of required documents (duly attested).

(B) SC/OBC(NC) STUDENTS FROM MAHARASHTRA STATE

The senior students from Maharashtra who are applying for PMS should first apply on-line for Scholarship through the website (yet to declare) of Department of Social Justice, Special Assistance before the due date and submit the hard copy of scholarship application alongwith photo copies of required documents (duly attested).

The junior students who have joined in this Academic Year 2018-19 should open their bank account in any National Bank before filling the on-line application form.

(C) ST STUDENTS FROM MAHARASHTRA STATE

The students from Maharashtra who are applying for GOI-PMS should first apply on-line for Scholarship through the website of Department of Tribal Affairs, Special Assistance <http://e-tirbal.maharashtra.gov.in> before the due date and submit the hard copy of scholarship application alongwith photo copies of required documents (duly attested). The students (Juniors) who have joined in the Academic Year 2018-19 should open the bank account in any National Bank before filling the on-line application forms.



Procedure for Opening Savings Bank Account:

The purpose of opening the savings bank account is that the Social Welfare Office and Tribal Affairs Office, of all States will remit the Scholarship amount of the GOI-PMS eligible students under the scheme of Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) directly transfer to their respective saving bank accounts. Please ignore, those SC/ST/OBC students already have their Saving Bank Account in the Nationalised Bank.

The documents to be submitted along with the application form of opening bank account are:

1. Photocopy of College Identity Card.
2. For address proof (any one): Bonafide Certificate / Aadhar Card / Electricity Bill (if, in the name of parents, then signature of parents on the same) / Driving License / Passport / Voter Identity Card.


The students will be required to produce a copy of their bank pass book to inform the SC/ST & EO Cell of receipt of scholarships for adjustment of fees due.

Procedure for Submission of GoI-PMS Application:

Offline/Hardcopy: All the eligible SC/ST/OBC(NC) students (other than Maharashtra State) have to approach/contact your District Welfare Office for SC & OBC(NC) OR Tribal Affairs for ST and request for GOI-PMS application form for the Academic Year 2018-19 (fresh/renewal). While collecting the blank application form, please confirm the detailed postal address of the authority concerned with name of officer and designation, list of required documents to be attached with application, last date of submission, etc. Please fill the application form properly, completely and attach all the required attested documents (three sets), and submit to the SC/ST & EO Cell (respective campus) well in advance and in any case 15 days before of the due date declared by the respective State Governments.

Online: All the eligible SC/ST/OBC(NC) students (other than Maharashtra State) have to visit the website of your District Welfare Office through desktop/laptop/mobile. Register yourself through login (if fresh) or use your last year login name & password (if renewal). Fill the online application form and upload the necessary documents, and take two printouts of the application. One printout is to be kept with you for your information and the other printout with all the required attested documents (three sets) have to be submitted to the SC/ST & EO Cell (respective campus) well in advance and in any case 15 days before the due date declared by the respective State Government. While submitting the application to SC/ST & EO Cell (respective campus), please provide the detailed address of your District Social Welfare Office.
