**[ GOI-POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME ]**

This is to bring to the notice of all SC/ST students who have claimed fees exemption that they are mandatorily required to submit the Government of India Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme Application Forms (on-line/hard copy) at the earliest along with all necessary documents. The list of documents required to be submitted are displayed on the Notice Board of SC/ST & EO Cell of your campus. Kindly note that the application forms of GOI-PMS (on-line/hard copy) are to be submitted **every year** (Fresh by juniors and Renewal by seniors).

It is the individual, eligible student's responsibility to fill and submit the online/offline application form of GOI-PMS for the Academic Year 2018-19 within the specific time frame announced by the concerned authority of the respective State Government. Students failing to fill the application form for any reason by the prescribed due date will be considered as not being interested to be considered for GOI-PMS and the entire exempted fees [including Dining Hall/Hostel Charges and advances, (if any), in case of seniors], will be recovered in full by the Institute. The release of the grades/degrees shall be subject to payment of all fees in such cases.

The State Governments will announce the details of the scheme and invite applications during the period from June to Decembrrt, 2018. The eligible SC/ST/OBC(NC) students should fill and submit the on-line/off-line application form within the time period specified by the respective State Governments. It is the responsibility of the individual eligible student to complete and submit the application forms.

Wherever the State Government/Authority Concerned have indicated that the GOI-PMS application form (hard copy/on-line) will be issued/accessed after 31 August, 2018, the students are required to submit an application indicating the tentative date of submission of GOI-PMS application form to the SC/ST & EO Cell of your campus.


**Procedure for Submission:**

**Off-line/Hardcopy:** All the eligible SC/ST (all States) and OBC(NC) (other than Maharashtra State) students have to approach/contact your District Welfare Office and request for GOI-PMS application form for the Academic Year 2018-19 (fresh/renewal). While collecting the blank application form, please confirm the address of the authority concerned with name of officer and designation, list of required documents to be attached with application, last date of submission, etc. Please fill the application form properly, completely and attach all the required attested documents (three sets), and submit to the SC/ST & EO Cell of your campus well in advance and in any case 15 days before of the due date declared by the respective State Governments.



**On-line:** All the eligible SC/ST (all States) and OBC(NC) (other than Maharashtra State) students have to visit the website of your District Welfare Office through desktop/laptop. Register yourself through login (if fresh) or use your last year login name & password (if renewal). Fill the online application form and upload the necessary documents, and take two printouts of the application. One printout is to be kept with you for your information and the other printout with all the required attested documents (three sets) have to be submitted to the SC/ST & EO Cell of your campus well in advance and in any case 15 days before of the due date declared by the respective State Government. While submitting the application to Cell Incharge of your campus, please provide the detailed address of your District Social Welfare Office.
