Background

Dementia in the elderly population currently afflicts million of patients and their caregivers, and emerging as a leading global public health challenge in the coming decades. The World Health Organization (2017) reported that 47 million people were living with dementia worldwide and numbers are likely to swell to 75 million by the year 2030. By 2050 the numbers of cases of dementia are estimated to increase almost threefold and the burden of the disease is expected to shift inexorably to low and middle income countries with 71% of those with dementia living in lower and middle-income countries.

In the given scenario, focus and judicious investment must become a global priority if we intend to improve the quality and coverage of care, develop comprehensive systems of social protection, health and social care and find treatments that alter the course of the disease and identify more options for prevention. Priority should be equally given to policymaking, health and social care service and health system development. It is imperative that the gap between treatment and care must be bridged for improving quality of life of those who are impacted by the disease.
