

Group Exercise for Paper Presentations for Vertical Interaction Course February 2017, TISS

As per a Directive from the BPR&D it has been suggested that all VICs should henceforth contain group work exercise in which participants work on sub-themes and develop a paper. A leader representing each group will present the paper on the last day. Papers will be submitted to BPR&D and they will be considered for publication in the Indian Police Journal.

Groups will be created by the course coordinators keeping in mind criteria like work experience, seniority, affiliations etc.

It has been decided that the main theme for the group exercise for the VIC this time is '**Training Needs for Democratic Policing**' with a focus on Induction training.

The Sub-themes under this are

1. Training needs at the Constabulary Level
2. Training needs at the level of Sub-Inspector and DySP
3. Training needs for IPS level/Senior Police Officers
4. Training needs for paramilitary personnel at cutting edge level

The paper should highlight the existing situation and review current practices. It should also identify gaps, and present suggestions. Examples from the field should be given wherever relevant.

A few reading materials will be sent to the participants along with the joining instructions. It is expected that participants will read them before they come for the course so that they have a background ready to begin working with. The course will have time dedicated for this work within its schedule. Please bring any training curriculum or reading material for all levels available in your State Police training Institutions / concerned CAPF training institutions.
