Greetings from TISS!

We are glad to cordially invite you to participate in the Vertical Interaction Course (VIC) on the basis of nomination from BPR&D for the “**Leadership Profile**” Theme at the Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) to be held from **6th – 10th February , 2017**. We request you to kindly take note of the following joining instructions:

1. You are requested to report at TISS, Mumbai campus on 5th February, 2017 evening (preferably) or on 6th February 2017, morning before 9.00 am, as we have the registration procedures from 9.15 am to 9.45 am on 6th February, 2017.
2. Kindly make your own travel arrangements to reach the guest house at TISS main campus located at V.N.Purav Marg, Deonar, Mumbai-400088 (Opposite Deonar Bus Depot). You may take a prepaid taxi from airport. (Route map enclosed). You may contact TISS reception (Tel no. 022-2552 5000) if any assistance is required for direction.
3. On reaching TISS main campus proceed to Guest house where your accommodation is arranged from 5th to 11th February, 2017. Food arrangements are made at Guest house dining hall. (Kindly let us know your arrival time before to organise dinner arrangement on (5th February, 2017). Given the limited resources, we would not be able to accommodate family.
4. The registration will start at **9.15 am outside the Old Conference Hall, Main Campus, TISS and inauguration session starts at 10.00 am at the Old Conference Hall.**
5. All VIC sessions are to be held at Old Conference Hall, Main Campus, TISS, Mumbai.
6. The Inaugural Address will be delivered by **Mr Julio Ribeiro, IPS (Retd.)** at 10 am on 6th February 2017, so kindly be on time to start the VIC sessions.
7. The programme schedule is enclosed for your reference.
8. **As per Directives of BPR&D, all VICs will have group work exercise in which participants work on sub-themes and develop a paper.** A leader representing each group will present the paper on the last day. Papers will be submitted to BPR&D and they will be considered for publication in the Indian Police Journal. To facilitate the same, reading material is attached herewith with this mail. participants are requested to read them before they come for the course so that they have a background ready to begin working with. The course will also have time dedicated for this work within its schedule.

9. Participants are requested to bring any training curriculum or reading material for all levels available in your State Police training Institutions / concerned CAPF training institutions.
10. On 10th February 2017, the VIC will close by 3.00 pm with the Valedictory Session. Kindly make your return journey itinerary accordingly.
11. We will provide you the training kit during registration with reading references.
12. The sessions will be in an interaction mode and we hope to have your active participation.
13. All sessions during VIC are compulsory, so kindly attend all the sessions.
14. You are requested to make your own arrangements for any local travel.
